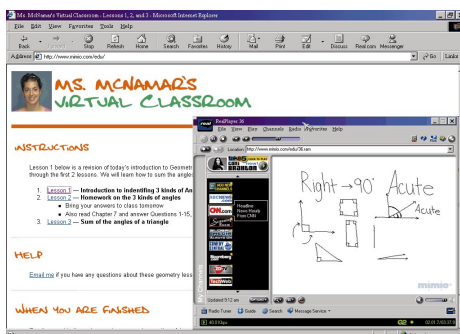

Turn your existing whiteboard into a powerful Internet presentation centre with mimio boardCast, the revolutionary communication tool that delivers streaming ink and audio together across the internet.



Using the RealNetworks G2 platform, mimio boardCast adds your voice to your whiteboard writing, so your audience can simultaneously see and hear your presentations - streamed live over the Internet, or archived for later demand viewing.

- Perfect for any one-to-many application: distance learning and lectures, corporate training and client presentations.
- Employs the RealNetworks G2 platform, the industry standard for high quality streaming media.
- Create presentations with any standard whiteboard, PC, mimio capture bar and microphone, so there's no need to spend thousands of dollars on elaborate multimedia equipment.
- View presentations with just a computer, speakers, and an Internet connection, using RealPlayer.

Think of all the ways you could use mimio boardCast with a remote audience ...

- Teach a distance-learning class and explain the details as the lesson progresses.
- Present options for legal strategies or estate planning. Draw the flow charts, outline the process, consider the alternatives.
- Deliver an all-hands presentation to your team members in remote locations. Everyone can simultaneously view the plans and hear the discussion.

Requirements to produce and publish boardCast media

For the boardCast producer:

- mimio hardware, mimio 1.11 software and the mimio boardCast plug-in
- 200MHz Pentium with 32 MB RAM (minimum)
- Windows 95/98/NT 4.x/2000
- SoundBlaster-compatible soundcard and microphone
- To publish an on-demand or live boardCast presentation, the producer needs access to a RealServer, either from their internal organisation or from a service provided (see: www.realnetworks.com)

- Web server access

For the department or service hosting on-demand boardCast on a RealServer:

- To deliver boardCast on-demand, the realserver requires the mimio boardCast file format plug-in. (Available for Windows NT/2000, Linux and Solaris.) This plug-in is available free at www.mimio.com (The boardCast file format plug-in is not needed for live broadcasts.)

Requirements to view boardCast media

It's easy to view and hear mimio boardCast presentations. You don't need mimio - just speakers, an Internet browser and RealPlay 7.0 or higher on a computer that meets the following requirements:

- 120MHz Pentium with 16MB RAM and 16-bit sound card and speakers (minimum)
- 28.8Kbps modem (recommended: 56.6 Kbps)
- Windows 95/98/NT 4.x/2000
